Ministerial Regulation

No. 5 (B.E. 2535)

Issued Pursuant to the Protection for Motor Vehicle Victims Act B.E. 2535 (1992)

By virtue of Section 5 and Section 13, paragraph two of the Protection for Motor Vehicle

Victims Act B.E. 2535 (1992), the Minister of Commerce hereby prescribes this Ministerial

Regulation as follows:

Clause 1 In a case of an intended termination of an insurance policy by a Company

before the expiration of the coverage period for any reason, the Company must inform the

insured of such termination in writing at least 30 days in advance via return-receipt registered

mail to the insured's last known address. In addition, the Company must inform the Registrar

of the termination within seven days from the date on which Company sends the termination

notice to the insured.

Clause 2 In a case where an insured terminates an insurance policy before the

expiration of the coverage period for any reason, a Company shall inform the Registrar of such

termination in writing within seven days from the date of such policy's termination of

coverage.

Clause 3 Upon any insurance contract's termination pursuant to Clause 1 or Clause

2, as the case may be, the vehicle's owner shall return any sign of insurance covering damage

to motor vehicle victims to the Registrar, or destroy that sign completely, within the following

periods:

(1) a period of fifteen days following the thirtieth day after a Company's termination

of insurance policy pursuant to Clause 1;

(2) a period of fifteen days following the date of the insured's termination of the

insurance policy pursuant to Clause 2.

Clause 4 This Notification shall take effect as from 6 October B.E. 2535 (1992).
